It is important to note that any object forming part of the movable cultural heritage of New Zealand, that meets the Act's definition of a protected New Zealand object, requires Ministry permission before it may be exported, regardless of its presence on the Nationally Significant Objects Register. The Ministry works closely with exporters and New Zealand Customs to ensure this happens.
