National War Memorial Advisory Council

Appointments to this body are under the National War Memorial Act 1992 and include the appointment of a senior serving or retired officer of the Defence Force who must be nominated by the Chief of the Defence Force. This position is currently under roll-over (pursuant to the Act) and an appointment under the Act is being undertaken.

All other appointments for positions appointed by Ministers and supported by Manatū Taonga are up to date.
