I refer to your request received on 14 June 2023, which has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), for information relating to property. Please find a response to each part of your request below:

1. How many staff work within your organisation to procure property (to own or lease) for your organisation.

There are no dedicated staff who work solely in property procurement. However, the Facilities and Emergency Management Manager has responsibility for property procurement matters as and when required. As the Ministry has a long-term lease of its current office premise (Old Public Trust Building, Lambton Quay), there are no current plans to procure additional property.

2. How many square meters of floor space does your organisation manage (owns/leases) in total, excluding any that is managed by the Government Property Group on behalf of your organisation, and how this compares to each year for the past five years.

Manatū Taonga is situated in the Old Public Trust building in Wellington. The leased floor space is 1,783.5 (m2). Information on the previous five years can be found here: https://www.parliament.nz/resource/en-
